Spearmint - **used to sweeten baths and rubbed on hands to help chapped hands**
St. Johns Wort - **a medicinal herb anti-depressant**
Wormwood - **used to kill lice**
Hyssop - **used to make perfume**
Catnip - **used as a tea, has a calming effect**
