

ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

1. Have the children create a timeline in class of each period and highlight the accomplishments of each group of people.
2. Have children imagine if the Bering Land Bridge connected North America to Africa, what kind of animals, people, and artifacts would they have left behind.
3. List five tools of earlier people and what they are made of and why. Then discuss modern tools asking the same questions. Compare and contrast the differences.
4. Make a clay pot in the style of the Adena, Hopewell or Fort Ancient cultures.
5. Plant sunflowers to remind children of the contribution of earlier people.
6. Pay tribute to the early farmers. Have a corn party. Look at packages to discover how many things have corn products in them.
